An ISSF final will be held for the assignment of the **Lisippo's Trophy** to the **ID NUMBER** ranking (for the cash prizes the ranking of the ISSF final will be respected).

- 1° class. Gold medal + Trophy
- 2° class. Silver medal
- 3° class. Bronze medal

An ISSF final will be held for the assignment of the **Lisippo's Trophy** to the **NO ID NUMBER** ranking among the first classified in the cat. E / 1/2/3 and of the Lady and Junior qualifications, the criteria for assigning the bib will be defined by the result of the 125 selection targets.

For the **NO ID NUMBER** ranking, the assignment of money prize in case of tie, will follow the Art. G.7.3.3 of the Federal Regulations

There are medals and trophies for all categories and qualifications.

“LIANO ROSSINI” CUP

The first 3 shooters of the **ID NUMBER** ranking and the first 3 of the absolute **NO ID NUMBER** ranking will access the 25-target barrage. Rules to enter the barrage are dictated by the Art. G.7.3.3. of the Federal Regulations. In case of a draw after 25 targets, a shoot-off will take place.

WHY LISIPPO

In 1964, two sailors from Fano found in the local sea a beautiful bronze statue, which was named after an athlete called Getty Bronze, also known as Lisippo (family name).

The statue is an original of the 4th century BC of Hellenistic culture and it was attributed by some scholars to the famous sculptor Lysippus official, portraitist of Alexander the Great.

It represents a young man who is crowned with the symbol of Olympic victory: an olive wreath.

Among the possible interpretations, the most convincing one identifies him as a Macedonian noble, companion of Alexander the Great who won a running competition in Olympia. It's believed that the statue was built in honor of Alexander the Great after winning the competition.

The statue was illegally exported, and it currently is in the Getty Museum (Malibu, California).

Italy has been trying for years to get the statue Lisippo sent back to Fano, as symbol of the city.

GALLIANO “LIANO” ROSSINI

There is probably no need to explain who Liano Rossini is. For those who do not know him... Liano Rossini, born in 1927 in Torrette di Ancona, was an industrialist, passionate about shooting from a very young age. He participated in 5 Olympics: Helsinki 1952, Gold in Melbourne 1956, Silver in Rome 1960, Tokyo 1964 and Mexico 1968.

In addition to the Olympic Games, he also achieved excellent results in World Championships, European Championships and Mediterranean Games.

Beyond his competitive results, Galliano Rossini was also a model of life and fairness. This anecdote tells us that... Galliano, before playing the final in Melbourne, in which he won the gold medal, decided to help one of his most serious rivals, Adam Smelczynski, to repair his rifle.

FANO

Fano is the third city of the Marche region, famous above all for its Carnival, one of the oldest in Italy, it's surrounded by hills on one side and the sea on the other, offers its visitors ancient monuments worthy of note and ancient vestiges of the past. Fano was an important Roman center known as Fanum Fortunae, which refers to the "Temple of Fortuna", probably erected to witness the battle of Metauro (207 BC). The visit to Fano Romana can only start from the Arch of Augustus, to continue towards the Augustee Walls and the Porta della Mandria. The imposing wall structures found under the Church and the Convent of Sant'Agostino are very suggestive and the collections of the Archaeological Museum in the Malatestiano Palace are rich.

The civic collections of Fano are kept inside the monumental Palazzo Malatestiano where the Pinacoteca, which houses authentic masterpieces, is located.

Fano is the ideal seaside location, water awarded several times for its purity, low tide, hotels and campsites within walking distance from the shore, restaurants where you can taste truly fresh fish, the pride of a city with a long maritime tradition. There is also a tourist port suitable to satisfy all safety and comfort needs.
